- > For a course to be offered, a minimum of 13 students must enroll. Courses offered:
 - CCGPS Algebra A and/or B
 - o CCGPS Geometry- A and/or B
 - Physical Science A and/or B
 - \circ $\:$ Biology- A and/or B
 - o 9th Literature- A and/or B

- World Literature A or B
- American Literature- A or B
- o Health
- o Personal Fitness
- > If a course does not have the enrollment required, a refund will be issued during the first week of June.
- Notification of enrollment will be emailed to the parent by Thursday, May 29th.
- > A student enrolled in a course that has an EOCT must retake the EOCT regardless of their prior score.
- > Parents or students must provide their own transportation.
- Acceptance to the program will be made upon review of the student's application, transcript, attendance and discipline records.
- > Attendance is mandatory. Do not plan vacations during this time.
- > All Walton High School and Cobb County School District rules apply during the program.
- Applications must be submitted to the School Counseling Office with payment (cash, money order or cashier's check) by Tuesday, May 27th. Money order or cashiers check should be made payable to Walton High School.
